**Community drop in meeting – Our Lady of Sorrows**

**July 11, 2017**

**Hydro One is working in your community**

Hydro One, together with Toronto Hydro, is making significant upgrades to its electricity infrastructure to provide adequate and reliable power to the west end of Toronto. Power West Toronto is required to strengthen the city's electricity system, accommodate the growing needs of homes and businesses in Toronto, and is required to electrify the Eglinton Crosstown LRT. The project involves refurbishing 10 km of overhead transmission line to accommodate additional power that will come from Hydro One's Runnymede Transformer Station, located at Jane Street and St. Clair Avenue West.

As part of the project, Hydro One will be working on the transmission line beside the Memorial Pool and Health Club and adjacent to Westrose Avenue this summer. To provide more information about the work involved, Hydro One will be hosting a community drop-in style meeting on July 11 at Our Lady of Sorrows Separate School.

Construction activities will involve removing selected vegetation, reinforcing the existing towers with steel, and replacing the overhead wires with larger wires to accommodate the increase in power capacity. The existing wood poles adjacent to Westrose Avenue will be replaced with taller, steel poles to ensure proper clearance from the ground. The area beside Memorial Pool and Health Club will be used as a set up area to pull a section of overhead wires. Safety is our top priority and a fence will be built to restrict access into the work sites; however parts of the corridor will remain open to the public.

We know construction can be disruptive and we are committed to mitigating as best we can. To ensure the community knows what to expect throughout the duration of the project, we invite you to drop in to our Community Information Centre to learn more about the project, ask questions and meet the project team.
